# SIRAK KWIZ BEE

## PAMANTAYAN AT PANUMTUNAN PARA SA KOMPITESYON

1. Ang kompetisyong ito ay bukas sa lahat ng Secondary Senior High Schools mula sa learning districts ng DepEd Schools Division Offices sa ilalim ng Lalawigan ng Samar.
2. Isang (1) kinatawan at isang (1) gurong coach mula sa bawat learning districts na binubuo ng tatlong (3) Schools Division Offices ng Department of Education sa ilalim ng Samar Province (Samar Division – 35 districts, Catbalogan City Division – 10 districts , at Calbayog City Division – 12 districts)
3. Ang pagpasa ng pangalan ng kalahok at coach ay magsisimula sa July 26, 2024 at magtatapos sa July 31, 2024. Wala nang ibibigay na extension sa learning district na hindi makabibigay ng kanilang representative sa itinalagang petsa.
4. Mayroong tatlong (3) round sa buong kompetisyon at isang clincher round para maputol ang tie, kung kinakailangan. Ang mga kalahok ay bibigyan ng colored paper strips para sa bawat round para sa kanilang mga sagot, gaya ng sumusunod:

**Round 1 – Easy Level (15 yellow paper strips)**

**Round 2 – Moderate Level (15 blue paper strips)**

**Round 3 – Difficult Level (10 Green paper strips)**

5. Ang pamantayan para sa pagbibigay ng puntos ay ang sumusunod:

Round 1-Easy	15 na bilang	1 puntos para sa tamang sagot	10 segundo para sumagot
Round 2-Moderate	15 na bilang	2 puntos para sa tamang sagot	5 segundo para sumagot
Round 3-Difficult	10 na bilang	3 puntos para sa tamang sagot	10 segundo para sumagot
Round 4-Clincher	5 na bilang	3 puntos para sa tamang sagot	10 segundo para sumagot

6. Ang bawat tanong ay ipapakita at babasahin ng kwiz master ng pagsusulit nang dalawang beses. Ang mga kalahok ay dapat maghintay para sa salitang "GO" mula sa quiz master bago isulat ang sagot sa loob ng takdang oras.
7. Para sa easy round, isang serye ng mga larawan na nagpapakita ng magkakaibang kultural na pamana ng lalawigan ay ipapakita at ang mga sagot na nakasulat gamit ang tamang pangalan at spelling ay makakakuha ng kaukulang puntos para sa round.
8. Para sa moderate round, isang serye ng maraming tanong na may apat na pagpipilian ang ipapakita at babasahin ng kwiz master. Ang mga kalahok ay dapat na isulat ang titik ng tamang sagot upang makakuha ng mga puntos.
9. Para sa difficult round, isang serye ng mga tanong sa pagkakakilanlan ang ipapakita at babasahin ng kwiz master. Isusulat ng mga kalahok ang sagot tulad ng inilarawan sa bawat aytem, gamit ang tamang spelling ng kinakailangang sagot.

10. Kung sakaling makatabla para sa una, pangalawa o pangatlong puwesto, isang clincher round ang gagamitin para maputol ang tie. Ang unang kalahok na nakakuha ng karagdagang puntos (3) mula sa clincher question ay mananalo sa tie-breaker.
11. Ang mga desisyon ng mga organizer ng kumpetisyon ay dapat na pinal at tagapagpatupad.

## SIRAK KWIZ BEE COMPETITION MECHANICS and GUIDELINES

1. This competition is open to all Secondary Senior High Schools from the learning districts of DepEd Schools Division Offices under the Province of Samar.
2. One (1) representative and one (1) teacher coach from each learning districts comprising of the three (3) Schools Division Offices of the Department of Education under the Samar Province (Samar Division – 35 districts, Catbalogan City Division – 10 districts, and Calbayog City Division – 12 districts)
3. Submission of names of the participant and his/her coach will begin on July 26, 2024 and end on July 31, 2024. No additional extension will be given to the learning district that cannot provide their representative on the designated date.
4. There are three (3) rounds all throughout the competition and a clincher round to break the tie, if necessary. The contestants will be provided with colored paper strips for each round for their answers, as follows:  
 Round 1 – Easy Level (15 yellow paper strips)  
 Round 2 – Moderate Level (15 blue paper strips)  
 Round 3 – Difficult Level (10 Green paper strips)  
  
 Round 4 – Clincher (5 White paper strips)
5. Scoring will be as follows:

Round 1-Easy	15 items	1 point for each correct answer	10 seconds to answer
Round 2-Moderate	15 items	2 points each correct answer	5 seconds to answer
Round 3-Difficult	10 items	3 points for each correct answer	10 seconds to answer
Round 4-Clincher	5 items	3 points for each correct answer	10 seconds to answer

6. Each question will be projected and read by the quiz master twice. The participants must wait for the word "GO" from the quiz master before writing the answer within the time-limit.
7. For the easy round, a series of pictures depicting diverse cultural heritage of the province will be shown and the answers written using the correct name and spelling will earn the corresponding point for the round.

8. For the moderate round, a series of multiple questions with four choices will be shown and read by the quiz master. Participants shall write legibly the letter of the correct answer to earn points.
9. For the difficult round, a series of identification questions will be shown and read by the quiz master. Participants shall write the answer as described in each item, using the correct spelling of the required answer.
  
10. In case of a tie for the first, second or third place, a clincher round will be used to break the tie. The first contestant who earns additional points (3) from the clincher question wins the tie-breaker.
  
11. Decisions of the competition organizers shall be final and executory.
