#### 4. Accuracy and Completeness: 20 POINTS

Accurately reflects the research study, including the research question, methods used, results obtained, and conclusions drawn.

#### 5. Impact and Originality: 20 POINTS

Emphasizes the potential impact of the research on the field, including implications for theory, practice, policy, or future research directions.

#### CRITERIA FOR RESEARCH PRESENTER

#### 1. Clarity of Research Objectives: 15 POINTS
