

- 9. If the school has already conducted CGP Orientation earlier than their schedule, they shall submit Full Documentation / ACR of the activity so their schedule will be cancelled.
- 10. In addition to this activity, schools offering G10, G11, and G12 may conduct middle-level skills fairs, job fairs, business and entrepreneurship expos, and other similar activities.
- 11. In the exigency of services and pursuant to the Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s 2004 on "Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered" and DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003; this is to authorized the **grant of service credits to teachers/DepEd Personnel** for work beyond regular functions or beyond regular work hours/days where payment of honorarium or overtime pay is not possible.
- 12. This serves as **TRAVEL ORDER** for the division resource persons and Grade 6 school heads, teachers and facilitators who will attend the activity in the district/schools.
- 13. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity such as food for the students, speakers, and guests/visitors, invitations, and venue preparation shall be charged against School MOOE, SNED-PSP, GPTA, and other sources of school funds subject to usual government accounting, auditing rules, and regulation.
- 14. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
