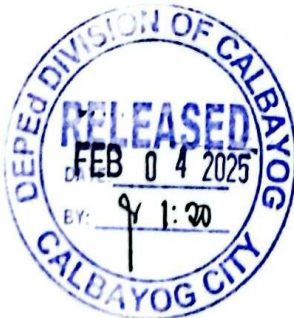
**PARTICIPATION TO THE THREE-DAY LIVE-OUT REGIONAL

1. Pursuant to the attached Regional Memorandum No. 090, s. 2025 dated January 27, 2025 (*see attachment*), this Office through the Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) announces the conduct of the **Three-Day Live-Out Regional Accreditation of Officiating Officials** at **Burauen Comprehensive National High School, Burauen Leyte**, on **February 7-9, 2025**. The said activity is in preparation for the 2025 EVRAA Meet.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. upskill and improve the officiating officials' knowledge of the rules, regulations, and best practices in officiating;
 - b. update the new policies and guidelines in their respective field of sports;
 - c. promote uniformity in officiating, foster continuous professional development, and encourage networking and collaboration among officials; and
 - d. uphold the values of fairness, safety, and professionalism throughout the sports event.
3. Attached is the list of participants and invited resource speakers of the aforesaid activity (*see Enclosure No. 1*) from our division. They are expected to arrive at the venue in the afternoon of February 6, 2025 (Day 0) to attend the Opening Program and other preliminary activities at 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon. The attendance of all participants, including the resource

speakers, is mandatory to ensure proper orientation and preparation for the following days of accreditation.

4. Participants shall bring their sleeping kits, toiletries, and other paraphernalia deemed necessary for the duration of the activity.
5. All participants shall bring and submit their latest **Medical Certificate** to make sure that he/she is physically fit.
6. Moreover, our Division Sports Officer, Mr. Oscar D. Billate Jr., is expected to be at the avenue on February 9-10, 2025 to join the team who shall finalize the selected officiating officials for the 2025 EVRAA Meet based from the result of the said activity.
7. No registration fees are required. With this, expenses incurred for transportation, board and lodging, meals, and others by the participants in the activity shall be charged against Local Funds/School MOOE/SEF/Other funds available subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
8. For Saturday and Sunday, all participants are entitled to Service Credit (for teachers) or Compensatory Time-Off (for school heads) equivalent to eight (8) hours of service per day consistent with the rulings under DepED Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memorandum Circular No. 09, s. 1988.
9. This Memorandum shall serve as the **Travel Authority** of all the identified participants.
10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

**THREE-DAY LIVE-OUT REGIONAL ACCREDITATION

1. In reference to the recently conducted series of planning conferences in preparation for the Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Association (EVRAA) Meet 2025 as per Regional Memorandum No. 1572, s. 2024, this office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), shall conduct a **Three-day Live-Out Regional Accreditation of Officiating Officials** at **Burauen Comprehensive National High School, Burauen Leyte, on February 7-9, 2025.**
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. upskill and improve the officiating officials' knowledge of the rules, regulations, and best practices in officiating;
 - b. update the new policies and guidelines in their respective field of sports;
 - c. promote uniformity in officiating, foster continuous professional development, and encourage networking and collaboration among officials; and
 - d. uphold the values of fairness, safety, and professionalism throughout the sports event.
3. The participants are expected to be at the venue in the afternoon of February 6, 2025 (Day 0) to catch up with the Opening Program and preliminaries at 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon. The attendance of all participants, including the Resource Persons, is mandatory to ensure proper orientation and preparation for the following days.
4. Attached is the list of Program Management Team, Resource Persons and Technical Working Group (TWG)
5. The participants shall bring their sleeping kits, toiletries, and other paraphernalia deemed necessary for the duration of the activity.

6. Only individuals meeting the following conditions will be eligible to participate:
 - a. Have served in lower meets and attended training/s in coaching or officiating for the sport they intend to officiate.
 - b. Physically fit and submit the latest Medical Certificate.
 - c. Not more than 55 years old at the time of the EVRAA 2025
7. Those who have attended the latest national accreditation in their respective disciplines shall not be recommended for regional accreditation but will remain part of the pool of officiating officials for EVRAA 2025.
8. Moreover, February 9-10, 2025, the 13 Division Sports Officers (DSO) are expected to be at the venue for the selection of officiating officials for the EVRAA Meet 2025.
9. The Division Sports Officer Shall finalize their list of participants and upload it to the registration link using the school DepEd Microsoft account: https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1A_R_EKdHckAIWFNwtaHQ1yZ_wJDluhVOqbVch9KAvb0/edit?usp=sharing
10. The traveling expenses including board and lodging of the participants shall be charged against the Local Funds/MOOE/SEF/Other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
11. Moreover, the participants to this activity who travel or render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays can avail of the Service Credits, CTO, or COC equivalent to eight hours of service per day whichever is applicable for DepEd Order No. 67, s 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 9, s. 1988.
