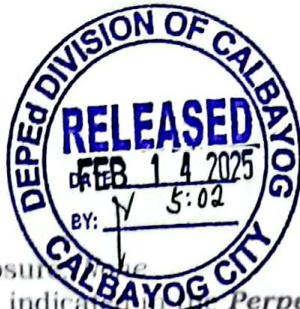

UPDATES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE 2025 CONCENTRATION TRAINING IN PREPARATION FOR 2025 EVRAA MEET

1. As stipulated in Division Memorandum No. 099, s. 2025, the concentration training is expected to end on February 16, 2025, however, for all other events to be played in Maasin City and Tacloban City, **the training shall be continued through school-based concentration training until the time of their departure to their respective clustered venue.**
2. All expenses incurred during the school-based concentration training shall be charged against the MOOE and other local funds of the concerned schools where the athletes, coaches, asst. coaches, and chaperones are situated/stationed, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
3. Further, all teaching, related-teaching, and non-teaching personnel who are included in the CCAA delegation for 2025 EVRAA Meet are entitled to claim incidental expenses amounting to three-hundred pesos (Php300.00) per day, chargeable against their respective MOOE and other local funds available, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
4. All other provisions in Division Memo No. 099, s. 2025 remain enforced.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
