

ESSAY WRITING CONTEST:

MECHANICS:

- This contest is open to all senior high and college students currently attending any accredited institution within Region VIII.
- The theme of the contest is the Community Relations Week theme, "SA PAMAYANANG NAGDADAMAYAN, SUNOG AY NAIIWASAN." Participants must ensure their essays align with the theme.
- 3 Each participant must submit their original work.
- 4. Entries must be between 500 words and 1,000 words using the English language.
- 5. The contest will be held during COMRES Week, which is scheduled for March 13, 2025, 8:00 AM, at the Calbayog City Fire Station Conference Hall.
- 12. The winning entry from the station level will be endorsed to the Provincial Office. Further, all entries from the respective stations will be voted by the Provincial Committee, entries with the highest vote for every category will be submitted to the regional office to represent the Province of Samar.
- 6. Entry to be endorsed to the Provincial Office must include:
 - a. Photo of the actual output of the contestant, including their name, school, and municipality/city they represent in .jpeg format.
 - b. A soft copy of the essay, digitally encoded at the station level without any alterations to the original content. Documents must be submitted in Microsoft Word format, with font style Arial, size 12, single spacing, justified, and with 2.54 centimeters margin on all sides.
- Winners will be announced on March 24, 2025, during the Judging Event held at the Regional Office Conference Room.
- 8. The awarding of the winners will be held during the Culmination Program of Fire Prevention Month on March 31, 2025, Monday.
- Participants may be disqualified for any of the following reasons: failure to meet eligibility
 criteria, not adhering to submission guidelines (such as format and word count), submitting
 plagiarized or non-original work, or including inappropriate or offensive content in their
 essays.
- 10. Judges' decisions will be final and irrevocable.
- 11. Winners (Regional Level) for each category will receive the following prizes:

b. Organization

Clear structure, logical flow of ideas, and proper paragraphing 20%

c. Language and Style

Grammar, spelling, punctuation, and clarity of expression. 20%

d. Creativity

Unique perspective and engagement with the topic. . 20%

QUIZ BEE

- 1. This will be dubbed "Hot Shots. The Firefighter Quiz Battle," a team quiz competition for students designed to raise awareness about fire safety and emergency response while promoting learning and teamwork in a fun, engaging way.
- 2. This contest is open to all college students currently attending any accredited institution within Region VIII.
- 3. Each city or provincial office will be represented by a team of three contestants, selected during the provincial-level quiz bee.
- 4. The quiz bee will test participants across a wide array of subjects, with questions spanning General Knowledge, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities & Arts, Health & Wellness, and Sports & Recreation.
- 5. The competition will consist of 4 exciting rounds, with 2 elimination rounds designed to narrow down the field and determine the top 3 teams. As the competition progresses, the difficulty level will increase with each round, ensuring that only the most knowledgeable and quick-thinking team rises to the top.
- 6. Knowledge Blaze Round:
 - Teams will answer questions in writing. They have 15 seconds per question to write their answer and must stop and raise their boards when the time is up.
- 7. Smokin' Scramble Round:
 - Contestants will unscramble letters to form a fire safety-related word within 15 seconds, earning points for each correct answer. A follow-up question related to the word will then be asked, with additional points awarded for a correct response. The two lowest-scoring contestants will be eliminated, and a tiebreaker will be held if needed.
- 8. Spark Signal Round:
 - Contestants answer questions based on photos, videos, or audio clips within 15 seconds. Correct answers earn points for the competing teams. The two lowest-scoring teams will be eliminated, and a tiebreaker will be held if necessary, leaving the top three teams to compete in the final round.
- 9. Rapid Fire Round:
 - Teams raise their flag to answer questions within 10 seconds. If the first team to raise the flag answers incorrectly, other teams can steal the answer which will earn them the points. The team with the most points wins the Quiz Bee Champion title.
- 10. Participants are not allowed to use cellphones, notes, or any items that may give an unfair advantage. Cheating will result in disqualification. Coaching from the audience is also prohibited, and violators may be disqualified.
- 11. Protests must be raised before the next question is asked. Protests raised after the next question has been asked will not be entertained. All decisions of the committee are final and irrevocable.
- 12. The winners (Regional Level) will be declared as 2nd Place, 1st Place, and the Champion, and will receive the following prizes:

- 4. The Station level contest will be held at exactly 2:00PM on March 13, 2025 at the Calbayog City Fire Station Apparatus Area.
- The winner from the station level will be endorsed to the Provincial Office. Further, all the
 winners from the respective stations will be voted by the Provincial Committee, then one
 with the highest vote will be endorsed to the regional office to represent the Province of
 Samar.
- Qualifiers from the provinces and cities must submit their original spoken poetry pieces by March 14, 2025, through email at <u>bfpr8competitionentries1@gmail.com</u>.
- 7. They will perform or recite their works on March 27, 2025, for a maximum of 5 minutes. No deduction shall be made if the contestants finish the delivery in less than the maximum time frame. 5 points deduction for every minute of overtime.
- The piece should be related to the Fire Prevention Month theme 2025 and must not contain any malicious or offensive content.
- Sounds, instruments, or musical background is encouraged and allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.
