2. The activity aims to:

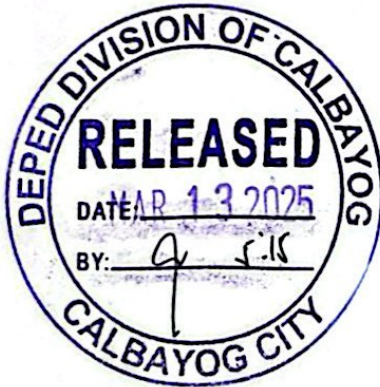
- a. deepen the understanding of District CFSS Coordinators on the principles and dimensions of the Child-Friendly School System;
